III. SCOPE OF WORKS

- The Contractor shall hold all the obligations, duties, and responsibilities to the completion
 of the contract assigned to be undertaken, including all labor, materials, equipment and
 services, other incidentals, and furnishings thereof in accordance with the specifications
 required by DBP.
- The Contractor shall conduct an actual inspection/survey and must verify all measurements at site and check the correctness of equipment location.
- The Contractor shall provide the services of superintendent who shall be constantly in charge of the installation works, together with all skilled workmen, metal workers, welders, helpers, and labor required to unload, transfer, connect-up, adjust, start, operate, and test the Inverter Type Air Conditioners.
- The Contractor shall be responsible for the restoration of existing structures damaged during installation and ensure that cleanliness level in the working area is being maintained and in compliance to applicable safety and environmental laws and regulation during the entire duration of the project.
- The Contractor shall supply and install new individual circuit breakers for each air conditioning unit.
- The Contractor shall supply and install drain piping to the nearest floor drain, to include PVC pipes and fittings, rubber insulations, supports and hangers.
- Workers should wear their company uniform and I.D within the DBP premises.
- The Contractor shall be fully responsible for the safety of his men (to be provided with Personal Protective Equipment) and clearly understands and agree that no employeremployee relationship shall exist between the Contractor's men and the DBP. Any damage caused by the Contractor or his men to any property of the DBP or injury or death to a third party shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor and the latter shall pay the cost or shoulder the burden thereof.

 All additional items, materials and workmanship not included in the scope of works but found necessary to complete the project and meet its objective shall be for the account of the contractor.

IV. COMPLETION PERIOD

The project shall be completed within **sixty (60) calendar days** including the actual **testing** and **commissioning** after the receipt of Purchase Order or Notice to Proceed.

V. WARRANTY

The Contractor shall warrant that the goods subject of the Purchase Order is free from latent defects which are not apparent during the inspection and testing periods.

In case of defect and/or any occurrence of malfunction, the Contractor shall be required to replace/repair the affected part/s with another new part/s with the same brand and model for a minimum period of one (1) year on both parts and labor including preventive maintenance services six months after the issuance of Certificate of Completion and Acceptance and five (5) years warranty on compressor to be covered by paper warranty.

VI. RETENTION MONEY

The obligation for a one (1) year warranty (reckoned from the date of acceptance) shall be covered by retention money equivalent to at least five percent (5%) of the contract amount to be released at the end of warranty period. The remaining warranty shall be covered by a paper warranty.

VII. PAYMENT

Payment shall be processed only upon issuance of Certificate of Completion and Acceptance by DBP.

VIII. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

The Contractor must pay DBP liquidated damages, not by way of penalty, but an amount equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of delayed goods scheduled for delivery for every day of delay. The liquidated damages will be imposed until such goods are accepted by DBP.

In case the total sum of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the total contract price, DBP has the following options:

- a. Terminate the contract pursuant to the Guidelines on Termination of Contract and forfeit the erring contractor's performance security. After termination, DBP may either (i) take over the contract; or (ii) resort to any of other alternative methods of procurement provided under R.A. No. 9184 and its 2016 revised rules and regulations;
- Allow the contractor to continue the works without prejudice to the continued imposition of liquidated damages until the works have been completed This does not, however, preclude the Procuring entity in resorting to Termination of Contract under Annex I of the 2016 revise IRR No. 9184



IX. DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Duly signed statement of Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) which is similar in nature to the contract to be bid amounting to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.
 - "Similar Contract" shall mean Supply and Installation of Air Conditioning Units for office space or buildings.
- 2. Product brochure with technical description.
- 3. Certificate / Proof of brand authorization as dealer or distributor.
